Hi Folks –

We are looking at the possibility of bringing the establishment OIC for the Pension Asset Panel forward as early as tomorrow to a walk-around / small meeting of cabinet just before PD&G.

In order to support this, we'd need to brief Ministers, whether together or separately.

Minister Sandals is in Frost post cabinet from 3:30 to 5:30 today for a PRRT Chair's Briefing.

I'm wondering if there might be a time this afternoon that could work for both Ministers?

Optimal times for Minister Sandals would be 3:30 (which would then mean moving the start of the Chair's briefing back) or 5:30 (just after the end of the PRRT Chair's Brief), but we could also split that briefing and do sometime in between.

If these ideas do not work, I'd suggest we work to find separate briefing times for the Ministers.
