Can't take credit here – The good folks in C O policy produced these two charts.

The PDF is an internal document, a year-by-year summary of government bills since 2013. The Bills/Acts that have provisions that have not yet been proclaimed are highlighted in grey. The yellow highlights are where the whole bill, or a significant portion, have not yet been proclaimed.

The excel document is a companion piece that lists the provisions that have not been proclaimed. Unfortunately, we don't have descriptions of the unproclaimed provisions and to do so would take at least a few days.
