CBC: It's a line on your hydro bill that can account for a major portion of your electricity costs. It's called the delivery charge. It varies widely from customers in different parts of the province. Premier Kathleen Wynne is signalling the government may soon offer some relief to people whose delivery charges are the highest.

Premier Kathleen Wynne: We have to really pull that apart and figure out how do we make sure that there is a fairness across the province in terms of the costs that people are bearing. There are many people who would like to see us deal with the delivery charge, but we haven't necessarily landed on how to do that.
