Hi Susan – I think this letter should also include what we have already done to reduce costs, such as removing the Debt Retirement Charge and bringing in the Ontario Electricity Support Program. There are other initiatives as well – they are outlined in the attached Throne Speech BG. Also, we should include the average savings from the 8% rebate - \$130/year – and the savings for the rural measures - \$45/month, as well as the fact that the ICI expansion will permit those in the program to save up to 34%. I think it would also be wise to hold this pending another energy announcement coming tomorrow.
