Hi Karen,

FYI – We just provided a similar heads up to senior management that we're anticipating that MOECC, and maybe even ENERGY will reach over on a senior management level to amend the discussed minute. We'll provide up with updates as things happen.

In the first attachment – Energy requested a change to MOECC's minutes at 10:30am this morning which we immediately communicated to MOECC. The ministry was not supportive of this minute and we proposed a compromise to the body of the note and the minute which was shared with MOECC in the second attachment at 11:40. We also shared MOECC's concern with Energy and also shared with Energy the updated minute/assessment note with our proposal to try and find a solution that could work for both ministries.

The ministries could not come to an agreement and we scheduled a conference call for 2:15 with all ministries to try and resolve the matter. Our understanding through the call was that all the ministries were referencing the latest note that was shared at 11:40. MOECC and Energy could not come to an agreement on the call and indicated they would brief up on the matter and provide an update at 3:15.

We followed up with the ministries shortly after 3:15 and both ministries would not move off their position, but our understanding was that MOECC was agreeable with the amendment we proposed just before noon and eventually took to TB/MBC (however; it's now apparent MOECC was not referencing the updated version of the note we shared this morning when they indicated they agreed).
