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Annual Reports

- ENE, MNDR, MNRF, MOL, and OMAFRA are tracking annual reports to CAB Aug 17.

ARD

- Standing monthly meeting rescheduled to Aug 22, as per Lindsay's request.
- PO briefing re Justice/Youth Justice Pilots scheduled for Sep 6, as per Lindsay's request. ARD recommends that this briefing is expanded to include education and child welfare pilots. Lindsay prefers that they are separate briefings. Cathy to set-up.

CCAP/MTCC

- SoC briefing re Linkage and Post-2020 took place on Aug 9. Gillian, Greg, and DM Davidson attended.
 - o SoC expressed concerned about the amount of money that could flow from Ontario to Cali when an auction takes place in Feb 2018. MOECC to address in Linkage submission.
 - o Tracking re Post-2020 TBD. MTCC Aug 31 too soon from Gillian's perspective.
 - o **Given SoC briefing, Aug 10 multi re Linkage was cancelled and may need to be rescheduled.**
- **Aug 17 meeting cancelled (no quorum and transition time for MOECC Minister).**
- **Aug 31 meeting shaping up to be Linkage only. Linkage submission to include global cap and risk/cost assessment.**
- **There may be opportunity to swap MTCC Aug 31 for HESP Aug 29 (or potentially ROF Aug 29) so that Linkage doesn't track to MTCC and CAB same day.**
- **Let's chat before Agenda Review. I think you'll need to raise the following MTCC Aug 31 items:**
 - o **Transportation Fuels (moved from MTCC Aug 17) – MOECC not ready**

- o EV Charging (moved from MTCC Aug 17) – Needs to move out since Minister Chiarelli is not available all week
- o Overnight Charging (as orig scheduled) – ENE to confirm readiness
- o First Nations Energy Projects (as orig scheduled) – ENE to confirm readiness

Corrections Reform

- Bi-weekly on Aug 8 cancelled, as per Lindsay's request. Next bi-weekly which includes health transformation (with MOHLTC and TBS) needs to be rescheduled, as per Adrienne's request.
- No direction from PO re tracking. MCSCS is working toward HESP Sep 26. Will need to go to TB/MBC.
- MCSCS consulted majority of stakeholders at one meeting on July 19. No surprises re feedback received (aligned with Sapers). MCSCS is drafting a summary report (requested at meeting). The Minister wants to post the report online to seek further feedback from stakeholders and/or the public. MCSCS still needs to meet with the IPC, OHRC Commissioner, and a few others.
- MCSCS expects a draft of the final Sapers report soon. Report will likely recommend high level principles to guide healthcare, and nothing else on health.
- MCSCS officials have not seen the corrections letter/memo nor know timing, and whether it will still happen. MCSCS MO driving this one.

ENE

- LTEP Modelling and DR meetings took place on Aug 2 and 3, respectively.
- Upcoming briefings (timing provided by ENE CoS):
 - o LTEP Comms 1 – Aug 23
 - o EVs/Overnight Charging – Aug 24
 - o LTEP Comms 2 – Sep 6
- ENE committed to discussing the LTEP modelling narrative with MOECC. May need an officials meeting to ensure both ministries are on the same page.

Leg Planning

- See e-mail attached.

MAG (Note: POR under Police Bundle heading)

- MCYS and MAG updated note re ACLC. Note further updated and draft sample TOR provided to PO on Aug 10. Will likely require further follow-ups via William.
- Multi re Mikisew (should Ontario intervene?) took place on Aug 9, as per MAG's request. Ministries expressed support for no intervention.
- PO support confirmed at POCO re Safe Access Zones tracking to HESP Sep 12 and CAB Sep 13. MGCS' item on FIPPA Amendments re Abortion Services to be on same track.
- PO briefing re CLA Adjudication scheduled for Aug 28, as per MAG's request (and PO supportive).
- Draft Family Law Act materials in hand. Note for LRC Aug 29 with MAG for approval. ECO seeking senior PO support at POCO before scheduling (on change chart). Lindsay supportive.
- Draft POA materials also in hand, but now tracking to LRC Sep 25 (drafting advanced but not yet complete).

Mandate Letters

- To reflect Cabinet changes, JRE provided input into the MOECC, MHO, MSW, and MFA mandate letters.

MCSCS (Note: SSO under Police Bundle heading)

- PO briefing re Nuclear Incidents took place on Aug 10, as per Gillian's request. ENERGY called in. In follow-up, MCSCS will clearly articulate the protocol of how nuclear incidents are handled at generating sites and at installations.
- Naloxone note in approvals (still outstanding from before).
- OPP Billing tracking to LRC Aug 29. Draft director-approved materials in hand. Note for LRC Aug 29 being updated.

MIRR

- MNO for discussion (DTC) and AOO for non-presentation at CAB Aug 17. Materials included in Cabinet binders.

MMA

- Mo prepared and delivered AMO binders.
- Multi re What's Next and the Local Share Campaign took place on Aug 10, as per MMA's request. Agreement reached on 1% HST messaging. In follow-up, MOF prepared a one-pager. MOF is awaiting Greg's okay to share with ministries.
- Greg requested a note for the Premier – meeting with AMO President. MMA drafting. Due Monday.

MNRF

- ROF bi-weekly and follow-up discussion re Marten Falls took place on Aug 8 and 10, respectively, as per Phil's request.
- PO briefing re Woodland Caribou rescheduled to Aug 23, as per MNRF's request (PO supportive).

MOECC

- PO briefing re SO2 scheduled for Aug 22, as per Greg's request.
- PO briefing scheduled for Aug 23, as per Gillian's request at POCO. MOECC to provide a few slides re EVHAP by Aug 18.

MOL

- PO support confirmed at POCO re WSIA tracking to JEP Aug 30 and CAB Aug 31 for both Work Related Illnesses, and Nurses and PSTD.

PERL

- SIB was unable to update MYAP's functionality so Mo developed a chart and shared it with MMA. Martha suggested we have a follow-up call with MMA when she's back to see how CO can further assist in facilitating the PERL discussion.

Police Bundle (SSO incl. Coroner's/POR/Missing Persons/Forensics)

- Presented at Major Projects on August 10. TB minutes revised to recognize the significant funding and FTE requirements in out-years, which will be brought forward to PRRT.
- At Major Projects, PO was firm that there will be no announcements until there is a joint comms meeting next week. At the SSO weekly on Aug 3, MCSCS discussed their comms roll-out (six announcements in total, starting with SWOP). MAG was not engaged on the roll-out.
- On track to TB/MBC Aug 16 and CAB Aug 17. MAG and MCSCS provided fast track memos.
- Will track to LRC Sep 12, as confirmed by Gillian at Leg Planning. No LRC materials from ministries yet (though have seen drafts of leg from TBS).
- No explicit direction re Forensics Oversight being in or out of the bundle. Will continue to track as part of the bundle until directed otherwise.

Vulnerable Road Users

- Obtaining a collaborative response from MTO, MAG, and MCSCS took a few tries (and Martha's involvement).
- MCSCS' separate product re police officer training is in development (still outstanding from before).
