Hi all,

I attended Leg Planning today. Here are the highlights relating to our items:

- Gillian suggested that all of the Elliot Lake items (MMA/MOL/MAG) should be "pulled out" of the Building Code/RTA bundle because of not being ready. So the CCAP Building Code and RTA amendments would proceed without Elliot Lake in the event that Elliot Lake is not ready (and she sounded very skeptical that anything Elliot Lake related would in fact be ready).
- Gillian said that she and Lindsay had decided that due to the expected lateness of the Tulloch review, the Access to Justice Bundle should move to the Fall.
- Gillian said that some form of SSO bill must still be introduced in the Spring to meet stakeholder expectations. Chief Leg Counsel advised that the SSO bill that gets introduced in the Spring could be withdrawn in the Fall, to be replaced with a more comprehensive re-write of the Police Services Act that incorporates all of the Spring SSO amendments as well as the Tulloch review amendments. Gillian said she would take that back for consideration.
