- Energy completed extensive public and Indigenous engagement in the fall-winter 2016-17 to inform the development of the province's next LTEP.
- Direct to Cabinet submission on LTEP components for policy approval June 27 (TBC) with weekly PO briefings leading up to the submission.
- Subsequent submission for approval of final LTEP document and OEB/IESO implementation directives anticipated in summer 2017.
