Regulatory Registry

- For the period September 28-November 12, the Ministry of Energy posted a proposal for comment on the Regulatory Registry to provide stakeholders with the opportunity to comment on the electricity mitigation initiative.
- The posting included the proposed changes to the RRRP, ICI and new regulations needed to support the 8% rebate.
- 7 responses were received. Key feedback received includes:
 - o Electricity Distributors Association provided feedback on all portions of the proposal, ENERGY's analysis was that suggestions were either currently addressed by the proposal or were outside of the scope of the proposal.
 - o Toronto Hydro sought clarification on the types of eligible customers and offered a suggestion REMOVE
 - o The Ontario Federation of Agriculture supported the expansion of the ICI, and noted that livestock businesses are not generally able to take advantage of ICIO, they are unable to lower electricity demand during peak periods.
 - o Hydro Ottawa noted the connection to electric vehicles, ENERGY's response is that future amendments may be required to align the rebate with overnight electric vehicle charging program, once the program is developed.
 - o The Ontario Greenhouse Alliance requested that the 'mandatory base year' be removed from the ICI to allow for immediate access. ENERGY will take this recommendation into account in the future, but notes that at this point it would be too administratively complex or include a risk of over or under collection of Global Adjustment.

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
