Bill Presentment

Over the fall/winter of 2017, the Ministry will be working with LDCs to undertake a comprehensive review of electricity bill presentment regulations.

The Ministry expects to prescribe LDCs:

- To include certain basic messaging on electricity bills;
- Starting July 1, 2017, for those eligible, include the First Nations On-Reserve Delivery Credit as a line item; and
- Prescribe LDCs to include bill inserts over the next year with OFHP messaging.

With respect to the OFHP, while the 8% rebate is expected to continue to appear on eligible consumer's bills, the further reductions as part of the GA refinancing and moving social programs to government funding will not appear as a specific line item. Starting in July 2021, customer's will begin to be invoiced the clean energy adjustment which will appear as a distinct item on their electricity bill.
