Hi nick and paul

Felix and I are working with Energy on their need for a Treasury Board approval for an operating asset that arises we think out of the attached proposed legislation. Having some trouble parsing the draft to see what is the linkage – can you maybe help us?

Below is what I know about the operating asset:

Energy or MOF – whoever injects the money into OPG in exchange for shares needs an appropriation (operating asset?) that has not yet been considered for the printed estimates. The amount could be sizeable, depending on when OPG Trust starts buying the IESO asset (e.g. approximately \$100M per month). Best guess we have on when that will happen is Septemberish of 2017 (before that OFA will loan funds to IESO to cover the shortfall).

All - Please find attached the draft "Intergenerational Fairness in Hydro Rates Act, 2017". A tremendous amount of work has gone into getting to this draft and much more work is required to get this ready for the House. The goal of sharing this document now is to further the process we have engaged in over the last weeks. In the attached, we have included notes to try to address where the drafting is not yet consistent with our thinking. These notes are neither comprehensive nor complete. They are intended only as flags and as colour to the draft. We have not forgotten the comments that you have already provided and we are continuing to working through the translation of the commercial terms we have been discussing into legislative language.

For ease of reference, included with the draft bill are the partially updated Blakes' summary, a chart that attempts links the articles in that document to the sections of the bill (which is imperfectly numbered at best) and excerpts from the Electricity Act and the Ontario Energy Board Act, related to the consequential amendments.

In your review, please focus on the broad stroke concepts, rather than the minutia, and keep in mind the cascade of instruments that will be required – legislation first, then regulations and finally commercial agreements. We look forward to discussing the broader concepts on Monday

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
