Subject: A couple of items

Hi Steve – Just touching base on a couple of items:

- Nucor – We are on it. Waiting for information from MEDG. Have discussed with Monique and awaiting response from Helen. Staff are meeting tomorrow to discuss reciprocal action on the procurement and legislative fronts and I will roll up a response to your earlier message by end of week with a status update and will cc the rest on that message.
- Kasi Rao called for our 1:1 today and indicated his call with you was cancelled. He advised there is still considerable backlash in India related to the resolution that was passed in Ontario about the Sikh massacre. He strongly recommends that efforts be made on the officials side of things to build bridges. To that end, he is suggesting you and I travel with him to India (Mumbai) for meetings with an India-Canada Business Forum and possibly go to Bangalore or Hyderabad given your interest in ICT for some meetings/tours of smart cities, digitized villages, etc. He would structure a program around your interests. The timing would be around Nov 21-24+ and I can get more details if you're interested. It does run up against the P's mission to China/Vietnam, but I'm sure we can balance that. My new ADM will be on the P's mission for the duration. I thought I'd put this to you so you could consider the timing and get back to me. Kasi is not recommending that this be a Minister's or P's mission for reasons related to the resolution.

Thanks Steve and will wait to hear your thoughts.

Subject: OBI Funding Renewal Submission - 2018 to 2024

On behalf of the Chair and Board of Directors of the Ontario Brain Institute (OBI), I am pleased to formally submit a request for renewal of funding for a further six years of operations.

We have delivered on our commitment to lay the foundation for Ontario to become a world leader in neuroscience research, commercialization and care. For the \$100 million you have currently invested over a 5 year period we have had an impact valued at \$305 million and we have well surpassed our current contractual obligations with government.

We believe that long-term, stable collaboration coupled with scientific and translational excellence are at the root of transformative impact. For this reason we are asking for a provincial investment of \$197.5 million over a six year period which will generate a total of \$470 million of impact.

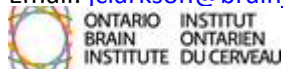

You were copied on this letter to Deputy Rodrigues re the recent DOW investigation at education. I contacted the Commissioner's office to seek clarification of what was expected of the Deputy given that many of the areas outlined in the recommendation are OPS-wide policies/guidelines and practices not within the control of the Ministry of Education.

Based on my conversation, I can clarify the general expectation:

- The Deputy will respond as it relates to the steps taken within the Ministry itself (for example, what steps have been taken to review the application of applicable policies and guidelines on the listed matters, steps taken to review other ministry practices, steps taken to educate senior staff on rules, procedures and expectations etc)
- You can respond as it relates to the OPS and say you have asked TBS, MGCS and others to review applicable policies and practices to assess whether we are adequately addressing the types of circumstances that arose in this case.

I think this should make the Deputy's response more manageable while also ensuring we give a corporate view.
