Hello everyone, here are the notes from the CAO Forum today.

- 1. TBS-MoF Update** (Tim Schuurman, Maria Duran-Schneider, Shawn Lawson)
 - Q3 – TBS needs to complete analysis and provide full fiscal picture week of Jan. 22 (quick turnaround) to determine whether government is at risk of meeting its fiscal plan objectives and balanced budget; to date, the budget remains off track, big gap to close
 - PRRT wrap-up scheduled for January 23rd (final fiscal impact decisions) and February (administrative /housekeeping items)
 - Document Process – initiatives submitted through ministers' offices, prioritization exercise underway
 - Estimates - instructions underway, timelines TBD
- 2. New Performance Rating Definitions** - (Diane McArthur, Chettie Legaspi, Ruth Ann Robb, Chris Kameka)
 - New Merit and In-Range Movement policy requires the move from a four-point performance rating scale, to a three-point scale for MCP Specialists, MCP Managers, and SMG1/ITX1 employees, for the 2017-18 fiscal year
 - CAOs supported the recommended approach to be proposed to EDC/PSC on January 26 and set for Implementation in 2018-19 fiscal year
 - Two options were considered; both provide three main categories: 1) Outstanding, 2) Fully Effective and 3) Does not Meet
 - The difference between the two options is that Option 1 (the recommended option) - has sub-categories that will support managers in providing feedback to employees; for example, "Fully Effective" has two sub categories (met expectations, and met most expectations) and this will allow a manager to give a "fully effective" rating to an employee who may be new to a role and did not fully meet expectations, but is on the right track i.e. moving away from length of time in a position determining an employee's performance rating (which has been a sore point in the past)
 - "Does not meet" has two sub-categories: improvement needed, and significant improvement needed (more useful when pursuing dismissal)
 - In general, the sub-categories allow for more flexibility and differentiation; require managers to be more thoughtful about their assessment; gives more information to employees; facilitates more effective performance management
 - As a result of these changes, minor amendments to the Merit Pay and In-Range Movement

policies will also be required (details to follow)

3. **Talent Management** (Diane McArthur)

- Informal discussion - Diane McArthur provided high-level observations about OPS of the Future and Talent Management
- Across the OPS people want to feel more connected, more problem-based work, cross ministerial work/thinking (less siloes); Westminster model may not line-up with a problem-based OPS; Across the board people want to make a difference
- Discussion around when/whether Finance and HR positions should require credentials; reasonable to fund staff in obtaining credentials
- Discussion around the CAO role and Succession Planning
- How do Deputies perceive CAO role, different ministries/business lines require different CAOs
- CAOs were encouraged to do more work around determining what's required for Financial and HR roles including the CAO role as part of a larger Talent Management/Succession Planning session

4. **Charge for Accommodations/Building Services**

a. Building Services Initiative

– Implementing new process to provide visibility to Ministry Clients for current Base Building Services (i.e. maintenance, cleaning, security, etc.) via IO software platform called 'Customer Portal'

– No impact on CPSD day to day operations

– Training is being conducted by IO Geoportal team January 2018 for Ministry

Representatives

– CPSD Accommodations Unit will attend when dates identified by IO

b. Charge for Accommodations

– FYIO - No Change to current CFA process

– CFA is the total occupancy cost charged to Ministries for use of buildings or properties.

– CFA includes: Base Rent, Operating and Maintenance, Realty Taxes/PIL, Management

Fees

– IO has transitioned to have all charge for accommodation (CFA) invoices paperless effective as of June 30, 2017. CFA invoices are posted monthly on Customer Portal on the last Friday of the month

– Operations & Maintenance costs steadily increasing year over year even though consumption decreasing - Increase due to rising utility rates

– Energy efficiency achieved through investment in equipment and continual improvements in building operations
