Question Period Report – Monday April 23, 2018

Questions:

1. MPP Fedeil (PC) to Ministers McMahon (TBS) and Thibeault (Energy) – re: The financial accountability office was very concerned about the Liberal hydro financing scheme and asked MPPs to make certain the auditor general approved, but not only did the auditor say the scheme does not meet accounting standards.
2. MPP Todd Smith (PC) to Minister Thibeault (Energy) – re: When did you become aware of Hydro One's new severance policy, for senior executives?
3. MPP Fife (NDP) to the Premier & Minister Jaczek (Health) – re: Explain how you are going to alleviate the problem of "hallway" medicine?
4. MPP French (NDP) to the Premier – re: We are offering real universal pharmacare and you're not!
5. MPP Wilson (PC) to Minister Thibeault (Energy) – re: Yesterday Hydro One released a statement about their new severance package for senior executives? Did you help them write it?
6. MPP Clark (PC) to Minister Naqvi (HouseLeader) – re: Your supposed government announcements are campaign style promotions, paid for by the Ontario taxpayer. The Liberals have held a total of 39 campaign style announcements. An estimated cost of \$7,500 each event. That brings the total amount spent campaigning on the taxpayers' dime by the Liberals to \$292,500. The Liberals are now under investigation by elections Ontario. These events have to stop. Mr. Speaker, would the Liberal party pay back the taxpayer?
7. MPP Tabuns (NDP) to Minister Thibeault (Energy) – re: Over the weekend an investigation by the "Globe and Mail"

confirms what the NDP has been saying for the past year. The **Premier** is wasting \$4 billion on a complicated private financing scheme whose sole purpose is to conceal the fact that she's using debt to artificially lower hydro bills prior to the election.
