Hope all is well. Your name was shared with us by Andrew Teliszewsky, Chief of Staff to Energy Minister Glenn Thibeault. On behalf of our client, the Association of Major Power Consumers of Ontario (AMPCO), we would appreciate the opportunity to arrange a meeting between AMPCO's executive and some of their senior members, with Mr. Hibben and Mr. Ed Clark.
