Please find enclosed the "Policy & Programs" submission regarding LTEP 2017 for next Wednesday.

About two weeks ago, at the last PO/CO LTEP bi-weekly, this was one 140 page deck. On advice at that time, we have split this into three items, but all should track into binders for Cabinet:

A) Main submission (Policy & Programs)
