They would like to see an introductory slide that just summarizes, sets the table by saying:

This policy will involve essentially three things:

- a. Lower electricity rates by an average of \$25% for all households and then, for the next four years, keep increases limited to the rate of inflation only
- b. Transfer a number of programs - such as the OESP - currently funded by ratepayers to the provincial budget
- c. Refinance the horizon for paying down major system investments – effectively easing the financial burden on current ratepayers imposed by the Global Adjustment

Then, to tighten it up a little:

- collapse the first section (overview of electricity system) into one or two slides
- collapse helping vulnerable consumers into two slides – one that lists off all the new programs and the second that shows impact (i.e. slide 17)
- collapse competitiveness into one slide
- collapse efficiency section into one slide that rattles off the initiatives
