Hi Andrew

My enthusiasm for the Premier's announcement that hydro rates would be cut by 25% for all Ontarians has been dampened by news reports today that the rate cuts do not apply to cottages. I was actually hoping for more since there were reports that rates for hydro users in rural and remote areas would be cut by up to 51%. The news reports that cottages are not included surely can't be the case. If so, the rate cut is not for all Ontarians.

In my cottage area on Lake Huron there is a mixture of seasonal and full-time residents. The full time residents use either electricity or propane for heating.

Will the year-round residents get the reduced rates while their seasonal neighbour pays a higher rate? Or will they continue to pay the higher rate because they are in a cottage community?
