Proposed Items for Review

1. 1. Amending O. Reg. 442/01(Rural or Remote Electricity Rate Protection) made under the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*.
 - This proposed amendment would update the Rural or Remote Rate Protection (RRRP) program, to provide increased rate relief to eligible rural customers (low-density customers of Hydro One).
2. 2. Amending O. Reg. 429/04 (Adjustments Under Section 25.33 of the Act) made under the *Electricity Act, 1998*
 - This proposed amendment would expand eligibility for Class A status to all electricity consumers with an average peak demand over 1MW, regardless of sector. Newly eligible consumers will have to opt-in, should they wish to participate. This regulation governs how the Global Adjustment is charged to different classes of electricity consumers. This includes setting eligibility requirements for being a Class A consumer (i.e., a participant in

the Industrial Conservation Initiative).

3. 3. Creating a new General regulation under the *Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, 2016*.
 - This proposed new regulation under the *Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, 2016*, would provide the necessary mechanics to support the implementation of the 8% rebate.
4. 4. Amending O. Reg 495/10 (General) made under the *Ontario Clean Energy Benefit Act, 2010*
 - The proposed amendment would prescribe a cut-off date for electricity consumers to submit Ontario Clean Energy Benefit claims to service providers, and a second cut-off date for licensed distributors and sub-meter providers to submit invoices.
5. 5. Amending O. Reg. 275/04 (Information on Invoices to Certain Classes of Consumer of Electricity) made under the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*
 - This proposed amendment is consequential to the implementation of the *Ontario Rebate for Electricity Consumers Act, 2016*
6. 6. Amending O. Reg 161/99 (Definitions and Exemptions) made under the *Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998*.
