Nadine – from my quick read of the documents I sent over this morning, I'm not sure there is clarity among the parties as to when the individual Ratepayers become responsible for the GA deferral. As I read it the draft leg creates the invoices at the time of the debt repayment (not at the time the GA shortfall is incurred), but the OEB has an issue with the concept, and I think its because they interpret that the individual ratepayers because obligated to pay for the deferred amount when the shortfall arises. It would be good to get the timing clarified.
