1. I don't believe the latest (October 2016) RPP Price report outlined the RPP portion of this debt. Does this mean that it will be covered from the May 2017 to April 2016 period through RPP rates, or will a portion of the debt be recouped by the Net Variance Account?
2. Can you expand on the actual amount of this debt that is still to be recovered by RPP rates and, if applicable, the Net Variance Account?

Thank you for your email. I am pleased to respond.

Funds related to the retroactive NUG payments for electricity generation supply were recovered through the Global Adjustment over the three-month period September 2016 to November 2016 inclusive.

Recovery of these electricity generation supply costs from commercial, institutional and industrial consumers occurred in these three months. For consumers on the Regulated Price Plan (RPP), rates are set based on a 12-month forecast of system costs and therefore the cost recovery is more spread out.
