Hey Kevin,

Samples are attached. These models have been developed by Alectra Utilities, and Hydro One. There are five customers modeled:

- A remote rural customer on electric heat (Rural – Low Density Area)
- A typical rural customer (Rural – Medium Density Area)
- A typical 905 household (Urban – Typical 905 Home)
- A low-income house eligible for the OESP credit (Urban – Low-Income Home)
- A typical small downtown business, like a family hardware store (Urban – Mainstreet Small Business)

Each customer has a before bill (based on what they would have been charged in December), and an after bill (based on a bill in July, after all our changes are anticipated to be in effect).

Extra info you may not want to include, but I'll add just in case you do:

Average bill impact in Ontario will be 25%; note that these customers all happen to be receiving more than this amount of support. Customers who receive less than the 25% will typically be customers who don't use much electricity (owner of an efficient downtown Toronto condo, for example).
