Hi Zee,

Good to speak with you on the phone.

As promised, I wanted to provide you with some more information about both RRRP and the OEB's move towards fixed distribution rates. I've attached documents that can help explain both.

For an overview, I'll simplify that the changes to RRRP for Hydro One low-density customers will bring their rates in line with medium-density bills, which is a pretty significant step-change.

In terms of the move to fixed distribution rates across all LDCs, the ones who will receive the greatest benefit are those with the highest consumption (i.e. in rural areas, using electric heat). Although, the change to fixed distribution rates will actually have almost no impact on most customers, and a relatively small impact on the others. (I'll add from my perspective that it also makes common sense, since the costs of maintaining the poles and wires don't change with the amount of electricity you consume).

The combined impact of rebating the HST and removing RRRP will be much larger than the proposed adjustments to distribution rates.

I hope this information is helpful in informing LIEN members. I'm sure many feel there's more to be done, and I venture that we agree with this and are exploring further challenges.

Despite any reservations, it would still be great if LIEN is able to speak to these measures as – at the least – a step in the right direction.
