Hi Meghan,

Thank you for taking the time to come down and provide me an update on the Tranche 1 CCAP Initiatives. As discussed, I have re-capped our conversation on each item:

- 1) Free overnight charging – will you be able to provide me a copy of the deck that your officials briefed you with and I can provide our feedback. Soon as Energy has a proposal, we can discuss how to tweak the program design to address policy concerns you may have.
- 2) Electricity Rates – Energy was minuted to work with MOECC on the proposal. Materials that are being created for the multi-corners should be jointly designed with MOECC. It would be great to know where the discussions are at right now and do you have any materials you can share.
- 3) Phasing out diesel within First Nations communities – the minute only speaks to creating an “implementation plan” and that’s why it is shaded in blue.
- 4) LTEP – as discussed, it would be great to get a copy of the LTEP Discussion Guide. Then, we can connect and chat about it.
- 5) Ontario/Quebec Hydro Agreements – would you have further details on what will be discussed at the joint Cabinet meeting on Oct 21 beyond what you told me yesterday.
- 6) Green Bank – Kaj to send over the deck.

As discussed yesterday, MOECC-led inter-ministerial committees will assess requests for GGRA funding and the Minister of the Environment and Climate Change will provide a final evaluation of proposed GHG reduction initiatives to TB/MBC, through the submission of the Greenhouse Gas Investment Plan (GHGIP) to TB/MBC, as part of the PRRT process.

The TB/MBC approved assessment and evaluation processes will be based on detailed evaluation criteria that will ensure the legislative requirements are met.

As mentioned above, it would be great to get the documents and then we can further discuss some of the ideas / policy proposals.

I really appreciate your assistance!
