Ontario's Government is taking action to help people in their everyday lives and ensuring access to affordable energy.

We've heard from families and businesses that the costs of rebuilding our power system after years of neglect require action, so today we're taking immediate action to fix the problem.

Our plan to reduce bills involves:

- Deferring up to \$2 billion annually in new electricity sector spending, saving the average family between \$15 and \$20 on each monthly bill for the next four years.
- Capping delivery charges at \$55 per month, saving the average rural ratepayer up to \$70 per month
- Enhancing successful programs that help low-income and rural customers, providing eligible low-income customers with \$540 annually and customers that heat with electricity \$1000 annually.
- Removing funding for social support programs from the electricity system – reducing costs to non-eligible consumers and recognizing these programs should be funded by the government.

This new plan builds on actions taken in the fall, and will mean real savings for customers:
