Hi Phil,

I am reaching out regarding the Premier's commitment to ensure that the net impact of cap and trade would not result in an overall increase in electricity costs for industrial consumers. There's a concern that this isn't on track and I wondered if you would have a moment to discuss further? The movement of the social programs from ratepayer to taxpayer is said to be, on average, equivalent to the carbon charge. However we haven't seen the calculations and hoped you might have more details. The OMA and a couple of our members have spoken to Craig Ruttan as well.
