

## **SNAP – 4-Month Plan**

### **1. Continued Implementation of OFHP**

- Next set of regulations tracking to LRC June 27, 2017

### **2. Long-Term Energy Plan 2017**

- Tracking for July 26, 2017 Cabinet for policy approval
- Will contain close to 40 initiatives covering all relevant policy areas with specific thematic focus on:
  - Encouraging Greater Consumer Choice
  - Maximizing Existing Assets
  - Enhancing Market Based Outcomes
  - Supporting Ontario's Climate Change Strategy
  - Encouraging Innovation
  - Enhancing Commitment to Conservation
  - Supporting Indigenous Capacity and Leadership

### **3. OESP Enhancements**

- Energy and MCSS have developed a 3-pronged strategy to increase OESP uptake:
  - Align OESP and SA eligibility, enable data sharing between SAMS and OESP and simplified application process
  - Increase awareness of OESP through MCSS targeted outreach
  - Fully automate registration of SA recipients into OESP

### **4. Bill Redesign Action Plan**

- Consultation with LDCs on how to simplify and improve electricity bills
- Develop new regulations for approval in Fall 2017 for 2018 implementation

### **5. East-West Tie**

- IESO to prepare updated needs assessment by end of 2017

### **6. Connecting Remote Communities / Wataynikaneyap Power**

- Negotiations between Feds/Ontario ongoing, potential for 2017 announcement

### **7. OEB Mandate Review**

- TB submission in September, potential for legislative changes
