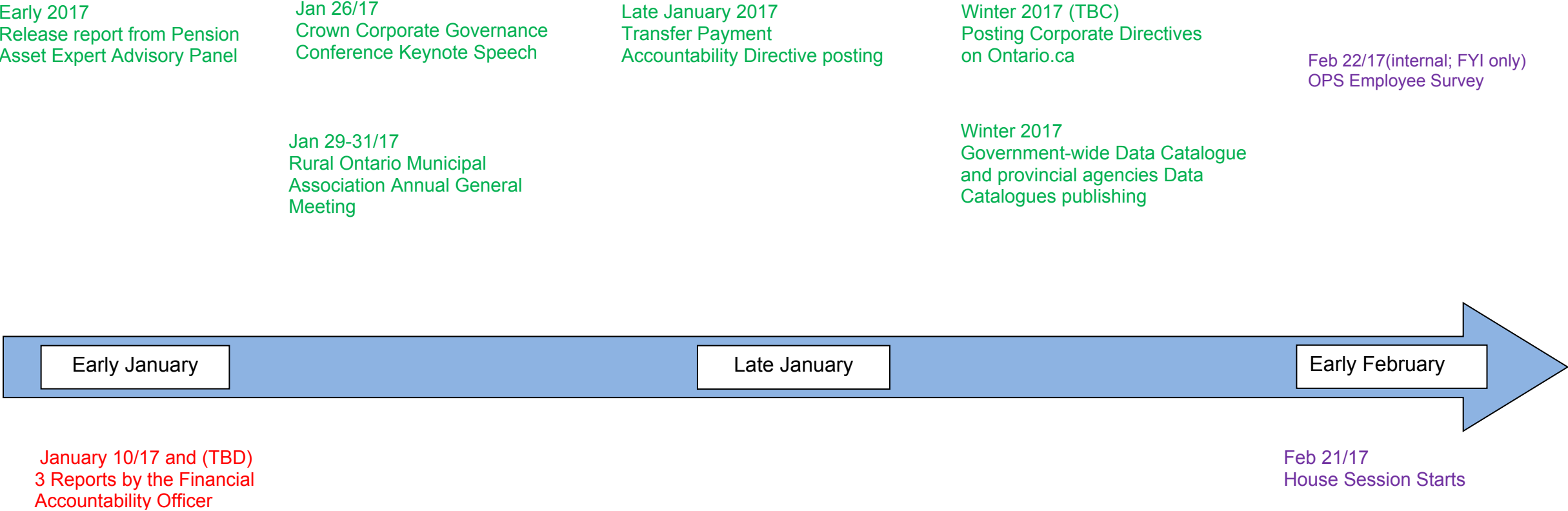

This transfer supports the new emissions reductions targets in the CCAP, led by MOECC, and consolidates climate change work into one ministry. Status: Products drafted by CFLL have been approved through to the Chief Talent Officer. Next Steps: Final approval of comms products; confirmation of announcement date, jointly with MOECC.

The last survey was conducted in 2014. The 2017 survey will launch on February 22 and remain open for two weeks, closing on March 8, 2017. Status: Communications plan and internal comms products in development. Next steps: Survey will be launched to all of the OPS on February 22, 2017.

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Judicial review of Ontario's response to the recommendations in the Sixth Justices of the Peace Remuneration Commission	Ongoing – reactive	Issues Note	TBD	Overview: Law firm representing the Association of Justices of the Peace of Ontario is asking for a judicial review of Ontario's response to the recommendations in the Sixth Justices of the Peace Remuneration Commission. On April 1, 2016, the Divisional Court granted the Association's motion for interim relief enjoining the government from implementing the changes to insured benefits for justices of the peace effective April 1, 2016 pending the outcome of the judicial review. The government is taking all possible steps to comply with the court order as quickly as possible. Status: September 20 & 21, 2016 – the hearing for the Judicial Review of the Government's response to the 6th JPRC report was held. There were two proceedings before the Court. The Application for Judicial Review of the Government's response to the 6th JPRC brought by the AJPO and the Motion to set aside the interim injunction against the implementation of benefits brought by the Crown. Interim decision granting partial access and notifying requester of 60 day time extension (due to volume of records and number of consultations) sent Friday, September 9, 2016. Decision to withhold responsive records in full placed in the mail Tuesday, November 8, 2016: - Records withheld in full under s.12- Cabinet Records; portions additionally withheld under s.13 – Advice to Government, s.15 – Relations with Other Governments, s.18 – Economic and Other Interests; Portions of the records withheld as they are excluded from the provisions of the Act in accordance with s.65(6) – Employment/Labour Relations Appeal Details: - Notice received from IPC on December 12, 2016 that the requester had filed an appeal. - IPC requested copies of the original request, decision letter and copy of the records at issue by end of day December 21, 2016. - Given the sensitive nature of the records, IMAPO engaged TBS Legal Services Branch for an opinion on options and risks of not providing the records (withheld in their entirety as Cabinet Records) to the IPC. Appeal Status Update: - TBS Legal Services Branch advised the ministry it must provide the records requested even though they are highly sensitive. - Requested documentation, including 1179 pages at issue, was provided to the IPC on December 21, 2016. - IMAPO awaiting further direction from the IPC regarding next steps.

Original Request Details Decision granting partial access sent June 11, 2015 (third party information withheld under s.17). TBS FOI received the IPC's order in this matter (PO-3663) on October 28, 2016. PO-3663 orders TBS to release information at issue in appeal PA 15-440 no earlier than November 25 and no later than December 2, 2016. TBS received an interim order of stay from the IPC on November 28th, 2016. Letter instructed TBS to not release records until further notice. Notice of Application for Judicial Review received by TBS on December 1, 2016. Appeal Details - On December 13, 2016, TBS received correspondence from the IPC inquiring whether the ministry objected or consented to the stay requested by the third party. Appeal Status Update - TBS Legal Services Branch sent correspondence to the IPC on December 15, 2016 consenting to the stay. - TBS is awaiting further direction regarding this Judicial Review.
