Hi Megan,

Please see attached my edits to your pink note – I have added to the version that Ron Kwan shared earlier. My comments are in the comment boxes, highlighted in yellow. I think Karen and Cindy have shared their comments on the GA piece, so as you will see, most of my comments are around the risks with the various electricity support programs. Some key highlights – though not sure if Energy would be able to answer these questions.

- We don't have a good understanding of the models/assumptions embedded in them to really verify the estimated fiscal impacts of the electricity support programs. As such, there is a risk that the forecast / estimates could fluctuate as models are refined (e.g. OREC). We're going to flag this risk in our TB note, but wanted to flag this for you as well.
- For our TB note, we are also going to flag the risks associated with program uptake and how this could impact the fiscal impact. For example for the OESP expansion, I'm not entirely sure how they forecasted the expansion cost – is it based on the current uptake rate (i.e., 30%?) or is it based on a higher rate?
- I have a number of questions related to the design of the programs as well – in particular,

OESP expansion and the Affordability Fund (which I also flagged the fiscal risks associated with the program and how it may not be one-time). I think a risk from a program design perspective that CO could flag is that we don't really have the data to really evaluate whether these programs are effective and achieving their outcomes. For example for OESP, if the uptake rate is only 30%, why wouldn't we look at whether the program is working well first, before we up the credits? Similarly, I'm not entirely sure why we would create a new Affordability Fund, without understanding whether the existing HAP program could be expanded – or modified to work better.

Anyway, we will be highlighting these risks in our TB assessment note – but not sure if it's worthwhile to mention them as well in the CO pink note.

I've included Patrick and my ADMO in this email – so that they are aware of the comments that I've shared. We might have more comments as we continue to review/as materials continue to evolve.
