Is the following sentence from the AG's Excerpt 1 supposed to be IESO's analysis or the AG's?

“However, the impact of the \$1.32 billion on electricity prices is expected to be marginal; without the subsidy, and factoring in the cost of cap and trade, residential bills are projected to rise by 25% and industrial bills by 14% by 2020; with the \$1.32 billion applied, residential rates will still increase by 23% and industrial rates by 13%.”
