Hi Steven, Martha,

I just got off the phone with Energy DMO and understand the draft fair hydro regulations are still in progress, and have not yet hit the DMO for approval yet. Given this, I think it is unlikely they would be ready for Cabinet this week although I know they are furiously working towards it. The ministry is also at estimates tomorrow, and preparing for the release of the AG's report (media advisory for tomorrow was sent out this AM).

For now, please find attached a draft LRC CBN that is currently out with Energy, TBS, MOF and MAG for fact check. Briefly, the regulatory amendments are to:

- Enable OPG to establish and charge fees, once the fees have been approved by the OEB, in its role as FSM. It would also provide the methodology for the calculation of those fees, and would define the role of the OEB in reviewing and approving those fees.
- Enable the recovery of amounts related to interest costs and Financial Services Manager fees ("carrying costs") in a manner consistent with accounting requirements of OPG and the Independent Electricity System Operator (IESO).

Re-sharing the draft LRC form also, so you can see both together.
