I am pleased to announce that Tim Hindmarch-Watson will be joining the Cabinet Office team as a Policy Advisor effective, April 5th, 2017. Tim brings with him a wealth of negotiation and policy expertise that will help him provide support to the Ministries of Indigenous Relations and Reconciliation, Northern Development and Mines, and Energy.

He completed his B.Sc. in Biology and Psychology and Master of Public Administration at the University of Victoria. When Tim is away from the office he tries to spend as much time as he can with his 2 year old son or running in the trails of High Park.
