Re: Long Term Energy Plan (LTEP) Variance from Approved Policy

Please be advised that the final document referenced above is consistent with Policy approval received by Cabinet on July 26, 2017 save and except for the following variances:

Proposed Variance	Rationale
The LTEP document includes the following: “the Province will work with the IESO to evaluate the development of a pilot project that explores the energy system benefits and GHG emission reductions from the use of electricity to create hydrogen.”	The decision to include this in the LTEP was made after the July Cabinet submission.

The IESO implementation directive includes the following: • “Identify options for pilot projects that evaluate the electricity system benefits, costs and GHG emission reductions of using electricity to create hydrogen” This was not included in July 26 Cabinet Submission or policy minute.

As a result of this comparison, I am able to advise you that the LTEP document and implementation directives correspond to the approved policy with the exception of the variances identified in the above chart.
