Dear Steve,

My name is Rene Alvarez, I am an Industrial Engineer, Master of Engineering from the UofT, professor of Modeling and Computer Simulation at the Faculty of Engineering UofT, and manager Business Intelligence and Analytics at MGCS.

I entered the OPS 10 years ago and started working “below the surface” in the second basement of the McDonald Block. After years of sacrifice and hard work, I have progressed in my career until getting this managerial position where I have completely transformed the way analytics are done in my organization, ServiceOntario. My efforts have been recognized internally and praised externally by the AG of Ontario.

After being a very successful OPS professional (I would strongly recommend that you speak to the Associate Deputy Minister and Chief Executive Officer, ServiceOntario, **David Denault** to get references from me) I have decided to move ahead in my career and have applied to several Director positions in the OPS. My latest application was to the position of Director Health Analytics at the MOHLTC. I can affirm that I have the leadership skills, the in-depth knowledge and vast expertise to become a successful Director. Indeed, in my opinion it would be very difficult to find someone in the OPS with more qualifications than me to take over that position. Please see my profile in [LINKEDIN](#).

Interestingly, knowing that I was the right candidate for the position, when it became available I received an email from the hiring manager (Executive Director Michael Hillmer) inviting me to apply. We also had an hour long meeting where we discussed my expertise and knowledge on the subjects. He even introduced me to the other directors and asked me to have meetings with them (please see attached emails).

After formally applying to the position I was invited to an interview, opportunity in which I provided a robust presentation with my vision on analytics (please see attached) and also provided robust examples to demonstrate my in-depth knowledge of the subject and my strong leadership skills.

Moreover, I shared with the panel an extract of an assessment performed as part of the Senior Leadership Program. Results are impressive and I got an average of 4.5 out of 5 in ALL the leadership dimensions. Also, the comments received from the evaluators (three ADMs, three Directors, three managers and three direct reports) were outstanding (please see extract attached).

After the interview I tried multiple times to communicate with the hiring manager to get information on the competition. However I received no answer. He even went on a three week vacation and did not provide the candidates with an update. After insisting many times, I was contacted by a Talent Search Consultant from the Centre for Leadership & Learning who told me that I was not the successful candidate. The hiring manager never contacted me again or responded my emails. This attitude is surprising given the fact that he was the one who invited me in the first place.

After several weeks, I learned that the position was awarded to an OPS employee who was not even a manager! (please see attached announcement). The successful candidate was a senior analyst at the MOHLTC. Her background education and experience are definitively inferior than mine as you can see in her [LINKEDIN](#) profile.

How is it possible that a person like this was promoted from an analyst position directly to a Director's position?

How is it possible that this person with less experience and qualifications than me got the position?

This situation totally undermines the OPS message that hard working and committed managers will be promoted. Indeed, the first time I spoke to my ADM and expressed my intention to progress in my career, I was told that it was necessary to have lateral moves to gather more experience as manager. Afterwards, I was told that to become a Director I must enroll in the Senior Leadership Program. The results of this particular competition clearly show that all those messages were inaccurate.

Even though I have been a hard working manager, even though I have demonstrated a tremendous success in every single task I have participated, even though I was enrolled in the Senior Leadership Program, and even though I was the candidate with the best credentials to get the position, I was passed over by someone who was not even a leader in the OPS!

**In summary, all this situation is completely unfair and contrary to the OPS values.**

This is particularly disappointing, frustrating and a very bad message for managers, including those in the Branch who now have report to someone who was promoted directly from an analyst position.

As you well know, managers are not compensated properly in the OPS. Also, managers who "manage" bad staff are subject to fierce harassment from Unions. On top of that, managers do not get the opportunities to progress in their careers. So, in summary it is not good to be a manager in the OPS. Too bad of a message.

I would like to have a personal meeting with you to provide more information about this terrible situation that has dramatically affected my engagement and my emotional wellbeing.

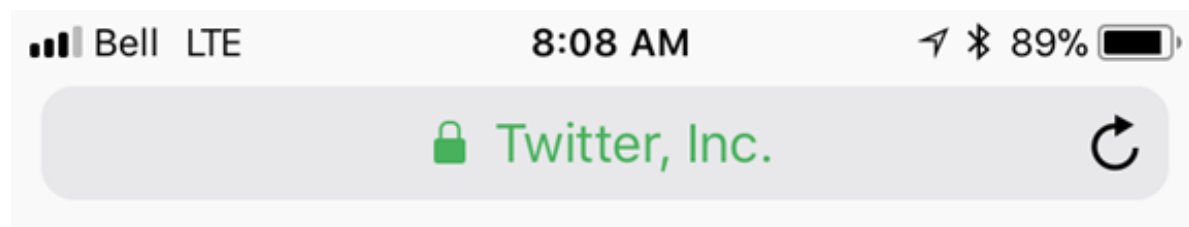

**Auditor General of Ontario's Special Report on the Fair Hydro Plan (the "Report")**

This week, Ontario's Auditor General uncovered an appalling attempt by the Wynne Government to hide the true \$4 billion cost of the government's hydro rebate scheme, a price which will be paid by all Ontarians.

The Auditor General concluded that the government is proposing to use accounting that does not follow its own policy for preparing financial statements under independently set Canadian Public Sector Accounting Standards. The Auditor General found that such a practice hides the real financial impact of the government's purported electricity rate reduction from Ontarians.

*"However, the government did not properly account for this debt impact from the electricity rate reduction in its 2017/18 budget and is not planning to account for it properly in its future consolidated financial statements. In essence, the government is making up its own accounting rules." (p.6)*

The Report outlines that, despite requests having been previously made to the Ministry of Energy for the production of related and highly relevant documents by the Auditor General, this documentation has not been forthcoming.

*The Ministry of Energy signed a contract, with a retainer of \$500,000, to receive help from a law firm to provide search services and to compile emails before providing them to us. At the time we completed this Special Report, the Ministry had still not provided us with all of its emails, which we requested on May 31, 2017." (p.6)*

Similar requests made by media under the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act, 1990 have also been refused on the basis that "no records exist".

In light of the revelations contained in the Report, and the necessity to get to the bottom of this highly improper conduct, we must insist that all records related to this matter, including, but not limited to, all sound recordings, videotapes, photographs, books of account and data and information in hard copy and electronic form be preserved. For absolute clarity, this request is not limited to the Ministry of Energy, but extends to all possible custodians in the provincial government.

You will see the letter reference FOI requests where the response was "no records exist".

I check with Jamie Forrest on any FHP requests with such a response. There was a CO request related to consultant costs, and the response was that no records exist. However, the letter went on to say that this is because the Cabinet Office did not retain any consultants for work on the FHP. The letter also went further to say that EY and KPMG were on retainer by OPG and IESO. So the letter was more than just no records exist.

The requester (media) tweeted that they were told "no records exist", but of course did not go on to reveal the helpful parts of the letter.

We should decide whether you want to address this in your response back to Mr. Brown's office, since if they were referencing only a media tweet, they did not get the full story. I think we should include this in your letter - particularly if Mr. Brown's office posts it or tweets it (which I expect they will). It is a good chance to get the entire context out there.

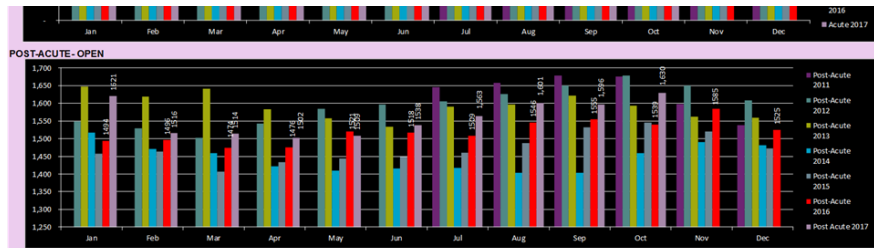
