See paper Dave Sawyer did in March. Dave Sawyer (and Chris Bataille) modelled two scenarios for how Canada would meet its 2030 emission reductions target (i.e. 30% below 2005 levels). Scenario 1 counts WCI imports, and finds that a national carbon price would have to reach \$150/tonne. That scenario assumes WCI price of \$45/tonne in 2030 (which is probably low). Scenario two does not allow for WCI imports and finds that a national carbon price would have to be \$220/tonne by 2030.

The key quote in the report is: "In our view, the inclusion of tradable global GHG units (WCI-ITMOs) reduces the overall national cost of achieving Canada's NDC. In effect, Ontario and Québec's caps and access to California's cheaper emissions reductions are doing some heavy lifting for the rest of the country. " (page 5)

On page 6 he concludes the impact on GDP growth to 2030 is twice as large under the no-imports Scenario 2 than with imported WCI allowances under Scenario 1 (while the economy does continue to grow under both scenarios).

I have also included the proceeds revenue forecasts through 2018, assuming 60/80/100 of sales of both current and future vintages.

Finally, I've included answers to questions on what will be released as a result of future linked auctions.
