In the last few weeks FRPO released a couple of reports which we forwarded to elected officials and public servants at the Ministry of Housing.

The first report attached is on the economic importance and contribution of vacancy decontrol to the rental housing market. It notes \$5.2 billion spent in renovations on rental units since 2012 and the policies important to the upkeep of existing rental stock.

The second report is on rental housing supply and notes an annual shortfall of 6,250 rental units in Ontario.

SUBJECT: Breakdown of Donations by United Way

In follow up to your request for a breakdown of the total donations received by each United Way office in Ontario from the 2016 OPS United Way campaign, please find attached a table detailing the amount received in pledges, workplace events and from the LCBO point of sale event.

In 2016, we switched our business model to the centralized campaign model, using United Way Toronto & York Region as the “host” United Way to manage on our behalf, campaign communications, financial reporting and distribution of donations to United

Way offices in Ontario. Under this model we received an accounting of funds raised province-wide, providing us with a better and more accurate understanding of our overall campaign results.

As this was the first year using this model, a number of regional United Ways failed to keep an accurate record of event dollars received from the OPS campaign and therefore, could not report event dollar totals to the host United Way. To accommodate for this and to get a better idea of how much each United Way raised through our campaign, the overall event dollars reported by some United Ways, were divided between all United Ways (except for Toronto & York) to provide an average amount.

Also attached, for your interest, is a breakdown of donations made to other charities during the 2016 United Way campaign.

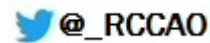

Secretary, Dep Betzner, Dep Torigian,

As per the snippet below, please be advised that CSIS in Ottawa is coordinatng a large scale, live fire terrorist incident exercise this coming Wed (Oct 18) with the full spectrum of security responders. Using a decommissioned federal building in the South of Ottawa, emergency and tactical response teams will be simulating a relatively large scale incident involving violent extremists.

Outside of the kinetic activities on site (which is likely to garner some media attention), we have requested that Ottawa include the OPSA in this effort. Our collective objective, of direct relevance to all of you, is the opportunity to exercise the TRIDENT PROTOCOL (see the attached "Trident Plan) for executive level communications in the event of a real or perceived terrorist incident in Ontario.

So, in brief, at some point on Wed, the OPP Commissioner will be contacted by role players in Ottawa and alerted to the beginning of the incident. From there, the Trident protocol will be invoked wherein DM Torigian and I will be advised. From there, a determination will be made that it is terrorist incident which will lead to DM Torigian advising the Secretary / CAB office.

Nothing else will be required or involving yourselves. For additional context, I've included two of our relevant assessment speaking to the need for enhanced terrorism awareness earlier this year.

No timing on when this will occur to ensure real life simulation.
