A possible new "wrinkle" for the IESO process for settling OFHP for IESO MPs. We are checking but it is possible when generation facility are in station service (drawing energy for station consumption and not injecting so net load), they might meet the criteria for OFHP. Somewhat a perverse outcome if it bears out to be correct – the facilities under contract that create the GA balance benefit from the introduction of a longer amortization in the recovery of the balance. I will let you know the outcome of the analysis.
