

Based on the decision The OEB updated the IESO issued early today that submissions related to, the receipt of Ontario Fair Hydro Plan (OFHP) amount is will be delayed until later in June.

Once the details of the OFHP submission are confirmed by the OEB, an information webinar will be held by the IESO to provide further clarity on the updated forms and any newly introduced forms. The date of the webinar will be communicated at a later time.

As per OEB's this direction, the IESO ask that the submissions of the RPP related information for the settlement month of May remain unchanged for the following impacted forms via IESO portal.

- * Regulated Price Plan vs Market Price – Variance for Conventional Meters
- * Regulated Price Plan vs Market Price – Variance for Smart Meters
- * Regulated Price Plan - Final Variance Settlement Amount
- * Ontario Fair Hydro Plan (OFHP) for Eligible Non-RPP Customers – LDC and USMP
- * The Ontario Fair Hydro Plan for Eligible Non-RPP Customers – LDC and USMP form should not be used at this time.

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As the forms have been modified to align with the Ontario Fair Hydro Act, please follow the instructions below to fill out the required information:

Even though The RPP Fair Hydro Plan Discount amounts are not required at this time. However, due to restrictions on the form, the new RPP Fair Hydro Plan Discount field cannot be left blank if the corresponding RPP variance \$ and kWh pair is filled out. Therefore, IESO request that enter \$0.01 to be entered into the RPP Fair Hydro Plan field along with any applicable RPP variance \$ and kWh pair.

Even though RPP Fair Hydro Plan Discount amounts are not required at this time, due to restrictions on the form, the new RPP Fair Hydro Plan Discount field cannot be left blank if the corresponding RPP variance \$ and kWh pair is filled out. Therefore, IESO request that the \$0.01 to be entered in the RPP Fair Hydro Plan field along with any applicable RPP variance \$ and kWh pair.
