Some edits – we need to add the requirements of FHPA (Bill 132), changes to OESP requirements as this is no longer rate based but tax based. Also we need to add the monthly requirements for FHPA – we report on DSP, FNDC, RRRP and OESP to the Ministry now. We need an updated RRR from the OEB.

Happy with your response to Julia on the need to report settlement audit twice.

Line 32 – OESP has changed and there is no longer a rate. O. Reg has been revoke on Feb 15, 2018. We need to provide reporting but not forecasts. FYI the updated OEB Act has been posted as well. We need to ask the OEB for the updated RRR as it is significantly out of date!

Line 43 – We need to update the wording to more actually include what is now provided to the OEB

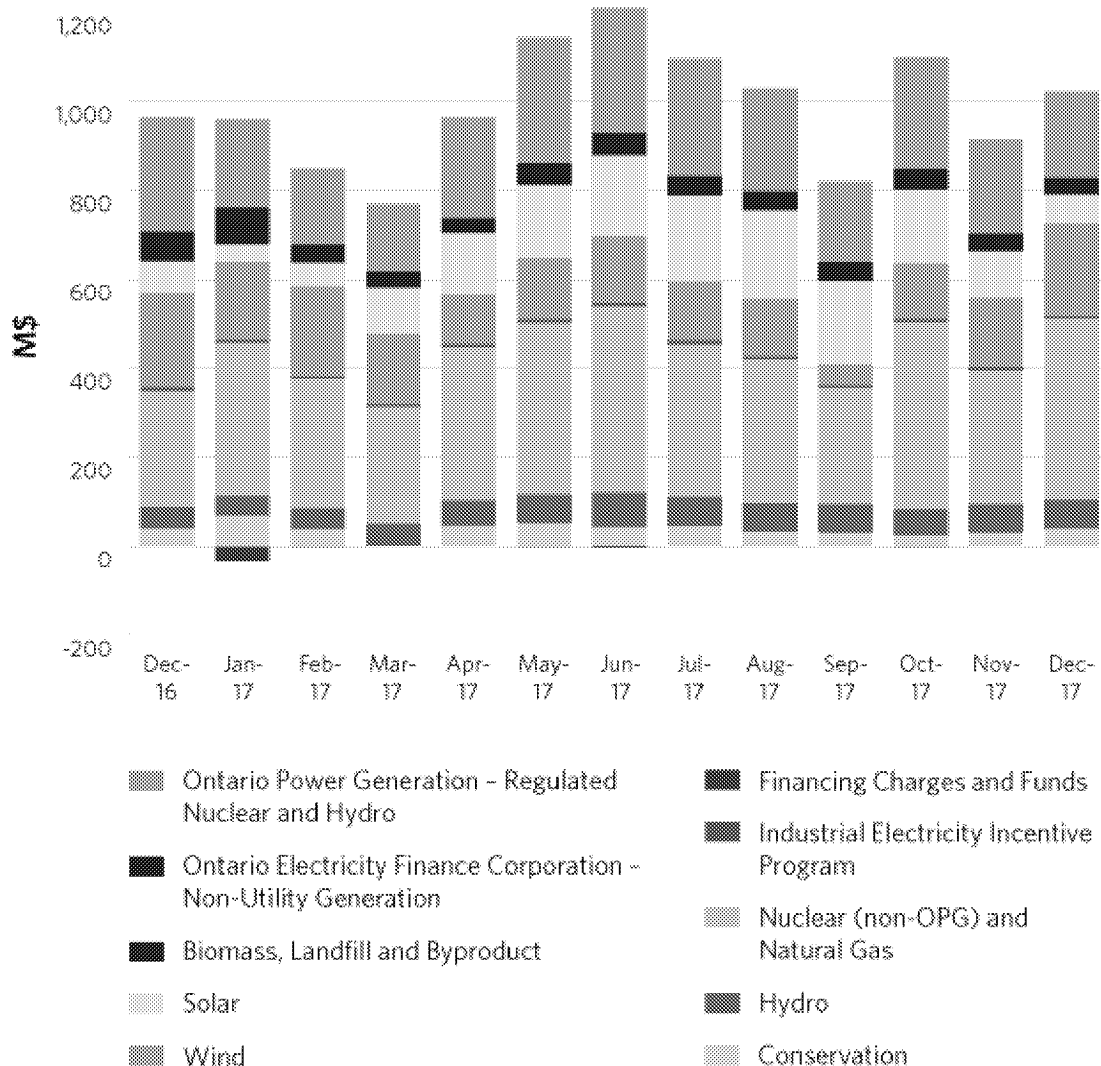
Line 44 – Ministry also receives this information

Line 69 – My understanding is that MRs no longer does MSP recommendation; it is Markets and Jason Kwok's responsibilities

Line 85 - I think we need to update the wording. We have a responsibility under FHP to provide specified consumer forecasts. Michael Boll and I can help you with those requirement details.

Also, I want to revisit why Finance is getting the information for GA by fuel type as we have had some issues with reporting – it may be our problem to fix but Regulatory Affairs needs to understand what is being done with the information and why. Is it just historical and can we do a better job? Is it really just contracts by fuel type that we submit? The chart below from our website indicates they are pulling prescribe assets which are not under Contracts. As well, do we exclude IEL, Financing Charges and Funds and Conservation in our submission? What I am suggesting is that it is whatever goes through GA. So who is picking up the new charges like low income conservation program from PEI? Happy to chat if you need further discussion.
