Hi Tim,

It's a great idea, but we're not in a position at this stage to provide any figures. We are hoping to have initial findings by mid-December that are based on the ongoing input from the working group and our third party consultants. The information we provided at the last briefing was only graphically indicative to try and show comparisons of the costs vs the savings. Beyond that we're just not in a position right now to include figures.

We'll be in later this year to brief the Ministry on the initial findings once the appropriate due diligence is complete. We are targeting to have a final benefits case in Q1 2016. Still a ways out.
