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Week In Review

This week's [energy headlines](#) include Hydro One president speaks to Windsor Chamber of Commerce, new research shows time-of-use pricing impact, and Waterloo Hydro contemplates merger.

The *Windsor Star* reports Mayo Schmidt, president of Hydro One, told the Windsor-Essex Regional Chamber of Commerce earlier this week bringing down hydro rates is a priority for the company, as privatization has created a greater sense of accountability to the customer. For Schmidt, customers in the province are also shareholders.

A new study from the University of Waterloo demonstrated smart meters and time-of-use electricity pricing have only modestly reduced Ontario's residential energy demand during the most expensive peak periods. According to *Clean Tech Canada*, the analysis showed residential demand for electricity dropped just 2.6 per cent during on-peak periods and 2.4 per cent during mid-peak periods following the change.

Waterloo Region is considering four possibilities for a possible merger of

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Waterloo North Hydro with another utility, according to CTV News. Several public utilities in the surrounding area were sold to Hydro One recently, or merged with other public utilities.
