Hi Karen,

Attached is an email that summarizes the proposed event, but I'd prefer if you didn't circulate further.

I would note that since the summary attached here, the Ministry and IESO staff met again and have concluded that the event would be targeted for October, and Ministry staff have confirmed that the payment for travel and accommodations would be done through the Ministry. The agenda is still in flux as well. But I would point out that two

pieces in which they are seeking feedback are on the ACEP program and possibly conservation programs. I flag those two in particular because those changes are expected to be announced through LTEP, so I suspect we need to be mindful of the timing and how it is presented.

Overall, I we're still hoping to do this, but not knowing an exact LTEP launch date will be problematic for a couple reasons. The obvious one being we would need to do this in a way that doesn't scoop anything LTEP related, and the second being that many of the people expected to participate will find it more and more challenging to attend the closer we get to winter, making October the likeliest month to target, and the one in which the communities recommended (outside of their September preference).

I hope this helps, but let me know if you have any further questions.
