As discussed this morning, please find attached the ministry's:

- Proposed net-metering impact assessment parameters
- Initial thoughts on the renewable DG program.

For your reference, I have also attached the email from ministry staff which includes additional context. The ministry has asked to set up a meeting early next week, but I am confident that we can have this pushed off to meet our needs, if necessary.

As discussed this morning, it is clear that the ministry has put some thought/time in to the attached proposal, and we should sit down as a group to discuss what our preferred approach, and in turn, feedback, will be (i.e. timelines, engagement considerations, procurement process/considerations etc.). With respect to the NM assessment, I have copied both Bashir and Phil here. I understand that PSP is working on forecasts for NM uptake which may help to inform this study. I also understand that the Conservation group recently commissioned a report on solar PV potential, which may also be relevant for this exercise.

In the meantime, please let me know what a reasonable timeframe would be for a meeting with ministry staff, and provide your availability.

Hi everyone,

As discussed, follow up attachments from today's meeting include:

- OEB's Implementation Plan work plan deck, shared at last week's meeting with ministry
- The ministry's modules outline/proposal. As discussed, this has been shared with the Resource Integration group with the expectation that a kick-off call with ministry will take place either tomorrow or Friday.
- Also attached is the Implementation Plan outline that was on the agenda for today, but that we did not get to. If there are any questions on this item, please reach out to Mary Bernard.

With respect to the DG/DER directive item, I will be working with the leads to determine availability for a discussion with ministry staff, and to discuss next steps. In terms of the updated directive language, the finalized wording is:

"Work with the Ministry of Energy to develop a program to support a select number of innovative renewable distributed generation demonstration projects, strategically located and paired with other distributed energy resources and smart grid technologies, as well as virtual net-metering demonstration projects. The program shall be administered by IESO, and will inform future grid modernization and net metering policies, support grid interoperability and be aligned with market renewal."

NEXT STEPS:

Based on today's conversations, the GA team will be reaching out to the ministry on the submission deadline for the Implementation Plan. A release date of the LTEP in late October/early November will not allow for sufficient time to engage stakeholders/communities, and we can start providing that feedback to ministry from now.

For next Tuesday's meeting:

- The intent will be to walk through the engagement scope of each of the individual directive items. This will provide an opportunity for WG members to comment on each plan, to identify gaps, and ensure consistency across the IESO and across all items.
- WG members will also discuss the prioritization/sequencing of directive items, being mindful of resource requirements and other possible internal/external deadlines etc.

Given that feedback will be used to inform the update to ELT, and the overall importance of this discussion, we ask that all WG members attend. If there is a scheduling conflict, please ensure a delegate is sent in your place.

Materials will be shared as soon as the plans are finalized with the SE group, likely next week.
