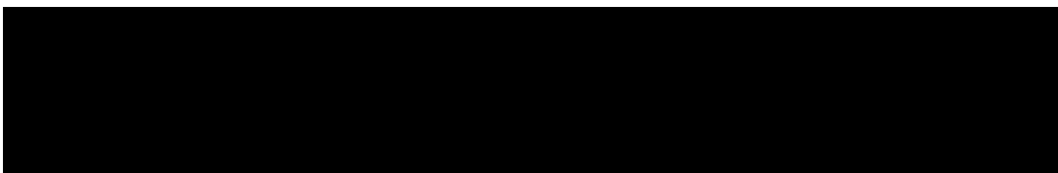

Michael,

OPG has discussed the attached framework with E&Y and there is an element that is missing (or doesn't work) from the financing entity's accounting perspective. My understanding is that, for the accounting to work for the Trust, the ratepayers have to have an obligation to pay, and the Trust has to have a right to collect from ratepayers, the interest/carrying costs during the moratorium period. So rather than the IESO having the obligation to pay those costs (and then passing them through to ratepayers through the GA), the ratepayers have a direct obligation to pay those costs (through the GA) and the IESO has an obligation to collect those costs for the Trust from ratepayers (through the GA).

Could that be made to work under the GA framework?

Would you be available for a call (perhaps later this afternoon) to discuss? We weren't sure how far this proposal has proceeded with the Province, but wanted to identify that without the element of ratepayer obligation to pay, it wouldn't work from the Trust's accounting perspective.
