Thank you for submitting the Project Proposal: Demonstrate Operation of Battery Storage and Solar PV in Parallel with an existing Combustion Gas Turbine Generator (GTG) to the Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) Energy Innovation Program – Clean Energy Innovation component call for proposals 2016.

The initial evaluation of the 346 proposals submitted to the Energy Innovation Program is completed.

The Program sought to support as many projects as possible; unfortunately, it cannot support all projects given the available funding amounts. The Project Proposals were reviewed by a federal interdepartmental review committee and ranked on a set of common criteria outlined in the Project Proposal Template and Applicants' Guide.

I regret to inform you that your project ranked lower than others on a number of criteria and has not been recommended for proceeding to the next stage at the present time.

However, if you are in agreement, Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) would like to maintain your proposal in a stand-by list for up to eighteen months following this notification, should funds become available potentially allowing us to explore some funding activities identified in your Project Proposal. The amount of funding available, if any, could be at a lower scale than initially requested in your Project Proposal, and any amended proposal information would need to be reviewed, prioritized and approved by NRCan before moving forward. NRCan cannot guarantee that any such funds would become available in the future.

It is essential that any information concerning the selection process for your project be kept **confidential** until Natural Resources Canada (NRCan) makes a public announcement of the approved projects.

If you are in agreement to be added to the standby list, please respond to this notification confirming your acceptance.
