On October 26, 2017, the Ontario government issued its latest Long-Term Energy Plan (LTEP) pursuant to the *Energy Statute Law Amendment Act, 2016*, replacing earlier plans issued in 2013 and 2010. The LTEP, which includes forecasts as far as 2035, sets out the government's goals and objectives relating to the electricity sector. The LTEP mostly reiterates and clarifies existing government initiatives, including the Fair Hydro Plan and the Climate Change Action Plan, while also creating various opportunities for energy industry participants in a decarbonized economy.
