Subsequent to the internal impact assessment and Technical Panel review of MR-00434 (Regulated Settlement – Deletion of Rural and Remote Settlement and Debt Retirement Charge), the IESO is proposing further amendments to the market rules to clarify that legislation other than the Electricity Act, 1998 and the Ontario Energy Board Act, 1998 may impose financial obligations.
