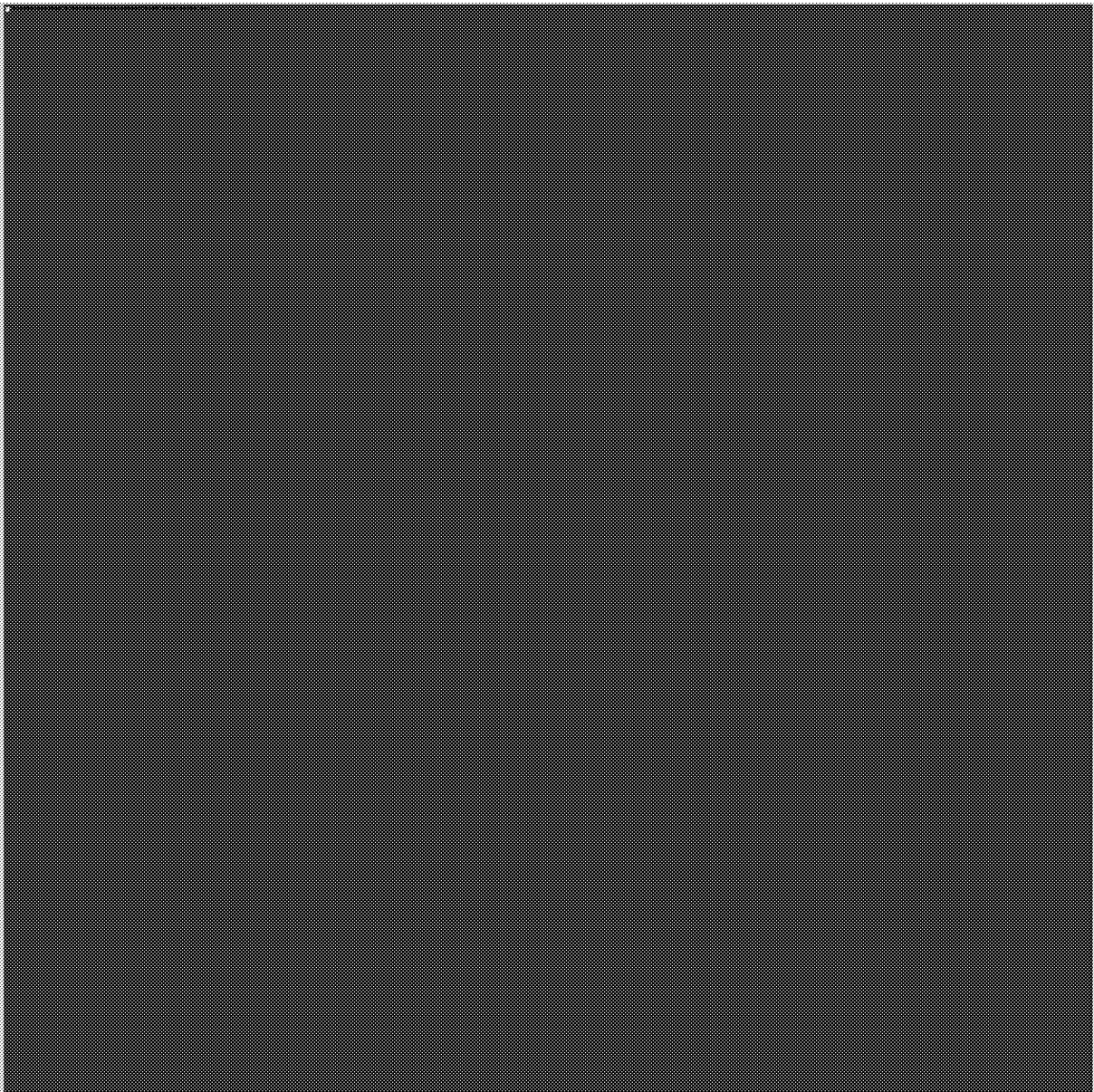
Highlights include:
