Accounting Changes

As of January 1, 2016, the IESO changed its accounting policy regarding the recognition of assets and liabilities subject to rate regulation. The change was made to better reflect the economic substance of the Smart Metering expenses which are recovered through the Smart Metering Charge.

This change has been applied retroactively and has resulted in an amount previously unrecorded as a regulatory asset representing smart metering expenses to be recovered from future collection of the Smart Metering Charge and the reduction of previously reported accumulated deficit.

The Smart Metering regulatory asset is \$21.6MM as of December 31, 2016 (\$40.8MM as of December 31, 2015).
