Hi Mark -- I have attached below the link to the IESO's HST guide (dated March 2017) which gives a brief description of all of the charges types found on the market invoice. Many of the uplift charges can be found in chapter 5.4 and 5.5 of this document.

With respect to RRRP, you are correct that RRRP is funded by rate payers and by the provincial tax base. The tax base pays Hydro One Networks. In addition rate payers pay amount as per O. Reg.52/16 amending O.Reg.442/01. The current approved rate set by the OEB is insufficient to cover the IESO's payments and so we are carrying a variance and debt for this account at this time.

Cindy suggested I touch base with you as you may be able to assist: we're working with EY on a product related to the FHP and one of the pieces we're looking to fill out is a description/details of uplift charges noted on the invoices issued by IESO – this is all fairly new to me, so I'm hoping that the context of this question makes sense. 😊 Also wanting to confirm a bit more understanding about the RRRP – my information is some, but not all of the RRRP is falling to the tax base – are you still carrying some RRRP in the amounts charged by IESO? If so, for what component?
